Start Point: 3:01

Drummer: John Bonham

Artist: Led Zeppelin

It consists of two bars containing four counted beats each.

This drum fill technically starts on the last triplet note of beat 4 in bar 1, played with the left hand. The hands then play a flow of alternating sixteenth note triplets (RLRLRL) on the snare drum up to beat 3 of the bar 2.

For beats 3 and 4 of bar 2, eighth note triplets are played. This has the effect of sounding like the drum fill has slowed down but it's the number of notes per beat that's changed and not the actual tempo.
